God of generosity and extravagance, we give thanks for all that we have been given. Help us to live your generosity in the world - expand our generosity so that all might live abundantly. Amen.



WEEKLY Connection and Reflection (Wednesday Worship):

12:30-1:30 pm, Labyrinth Room Join us for a time of reflection and conversation. Held in the beautiful Labyrinth Room, framed with music, readings, and a time for silence and quiet reflection, we will come together to listen, to talk, and to be in community together. All are welcome.

WEEKLY Sermon Series: Short Stories by Jesus Starting June 4, for six weeks, our themes and reflections will draw heavily from scholar Amy-Jill Levine and her book, "Short Stories by Jesus."
